Psalms 133

“How wonderful it is, how pleasant, for God's people to live together in harmony! It is like the precious anointing oil running down from Aaron's head and beard, down to the collar of his robes. It is like the dew on Mount Hermon, falling on the hills of Zion. That is where the LORD has promised his blessing—life that never ends.”

We stand on the promises of God to reach the treasures out of darkness and expand our territory (Isaiah 45:2-3 & 54:2-3). Daniel 9:3 MSG

“I turned to the Master God, asking for an answer—praying earnestly, fasting from meals, wearing rough penitential burlap, and kneeling in the ashes. I poured out my heart, baring my soul to GOD, my God.”

1. 5 Days of fasting food at some level (Daniel, Juice, Water, or just eating one meal/day).
2. Scheduling time to focus on seeking God.
3. 5 days off from Social Media and Entertainment.
4. 5 Days devoted to prayer, worship, and repentance with families and God's people.

DAILY PRAYER TARGETS

DAY 1: (Monday September 20th)

PRAYER TARGET: Repentance & Spiritual Awakening

Matthew 3:2 – “and saying, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!”

Revelations 2:7 - “Are your ears awake? Listen. Listen to the Wind Words, the Spirit blowing through the churches. I'm about to call each conqueror to dinner. I'm spreading a banquet of Tree-of-Life fruit, a supper plucked from God's orchard.”

- Breaking the religious spirit

DAY 2: (Tuesday September 21st)

PRAYER TARGET: Spiritual Maturity

Ephesians 4:13-14 – “until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ. Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming.”

DAY 4: (Thursday September 23rd)

PRAYER TARGET: Strengthen & Expansion of the Church
