 For Three Days of Fasting and Prayer
 October 26-28, 2021

Joel 2:12–13 (NLT) 12 That is why the LORD says, “Turn to me now, while there is time. Give me your hearts. Come with fasting, weeping, and mourning. **13** Don’t tear your clothing in your grief, but tear your hearts instead.” Return to the LORD your God, for he is merciful and compassionate, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love. He is eager to relent and not punish.

Three Days of Fasting and Prayer:

For His Presence, His Provision and His Power.

1. Presence:

Exodus 33:15–17 (NIV) — 15 Then Moses said to him, “If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here. **16** How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with your people unless you go with us? What else will distinguish me and your people from all the other people on the face of the earth?” **17** And the LORD said to Moses, “I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name.”

Hebrews 12:14 (NKJV) Pursue peace with all people,
 and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord:

2 Corinthians 6:16–18 (NIV) 16 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: “I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they will be my people.” **17** Therefore, “Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you.” **18** And, “I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty.”
